4.94 Mill Emergency Operating Levy

March 17, 2020 - ISSUE 1



Issue 1 is an Emergency Operating Levy. It is used for classroom instruction - NOT construction.

Here are some key facts regarding the levy:

✓ If the March levy passes, the district will be able to plan for increases in funding and will be able to recover the funds that were cut by the State of Ohio. With these funds, the district plans to reinstate cuts that were made in November. However, because the district will have been operating in deficit spending for an additional year, it will still be necessary to hold approximately \$2.5 million in cuts from phase 2. These will be cuts such as employee pay freezes and cuts to building budgets.
